Prerequisite: Digital Threat Assessment

Building upon the Digital Threat Assessment class by Safer Schools Together, Advanced Digital Threat Assessment will leave participants with a concrete understanding of how to find and curate relevant

digital information as is typically represented in a real-life digital threat assessment data gathering scenario. Major engagement and hands-on practice will take place as participants are assembled into investigative teams and given a mock real-life scenario. The final practical assignment will consist of working collaboratively as a team to navigate the realms of the social media world using both familiar and new techniques to produce a digital baseline report using a template. Participants will receive templates and supplied standard operating procedures to leave with confidence in being able to independently establish a threat makers' digital baseline and produce a comprehensive report.

Note:

You will need to use a laptop, Macbook, Microsoft Surface or Google Chromebook to get the most from the hands-on portion of the training. Tablets are not compatible with some aspects of the training, and iPads have limited searching capabilities. Your computer will need to have firewalls disabled and unrestricted Wi-Fi access for this training. Please test your connectivity to a public network before attending. It is also strongly recommended that you have an Instagram account in place to get the most out of this training.
